Students from eight Los Angeles area elementary and middle schools are set to participate with hundreds of Long Beach children in field trips at the **Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach on April 19 - 21, 2013**. The kids will be treated to Racers Who Care Quick Tips on Winning in Life life skills presentations made by several pro-racers and take racerguided Paddock Tours to see the Tips being enacted in real life by race teams.

Arranged through Leo Gallardo, of the L.A. All-Stars after school program provider, students are participating from Inglewood Elementary School, View Park Middle School, Downtown Value School, Kohyang Middle School and the Suva Intermediate School. Participating through the coordination of Manuel McLeod, of the Champions for Charters after school program provider, students are participating from Los Angeles' Magnolia Science Academy and Bret Harte Middle School.
