Antron's fastest Top Fuel speed is 331.94 m.p.h. Prior to entering the Top Fuel ranks in 2008, Brown spent 10 years as an NHRA Pro Stock Motorcycle competitor. He is the only driver in NHRA history to have won races and led the standings in both the Top Fuel and Pro Stock Motorcycle categories.
