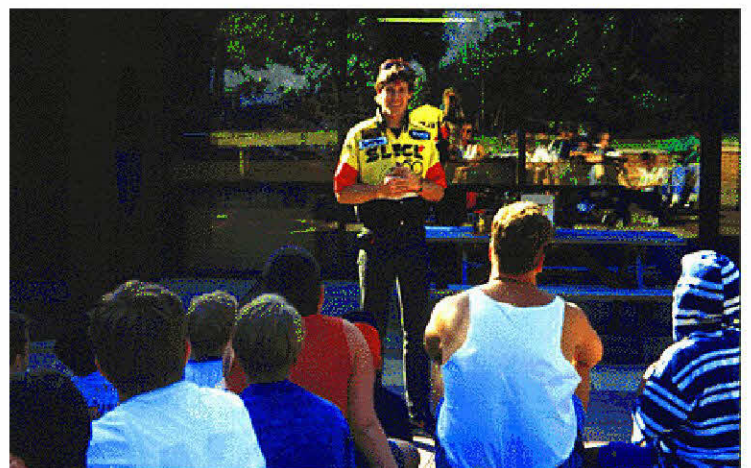
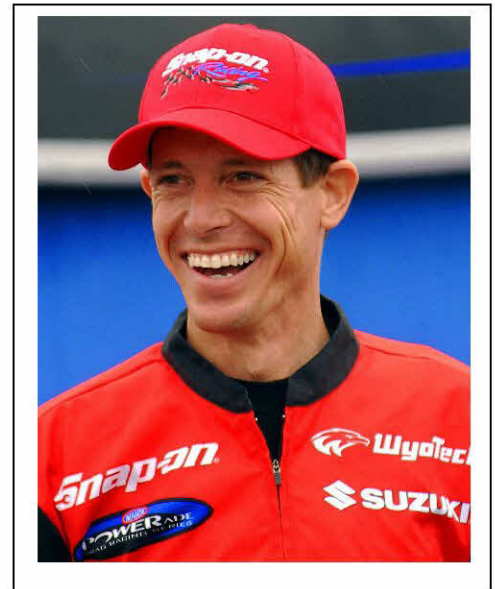
He rides a Suzuki Pro Stock drag bike for the Steve Johnson Racing Team in the National Hot Rod Association's Full Throttle series tour Pro Stock Motorcycle Class.

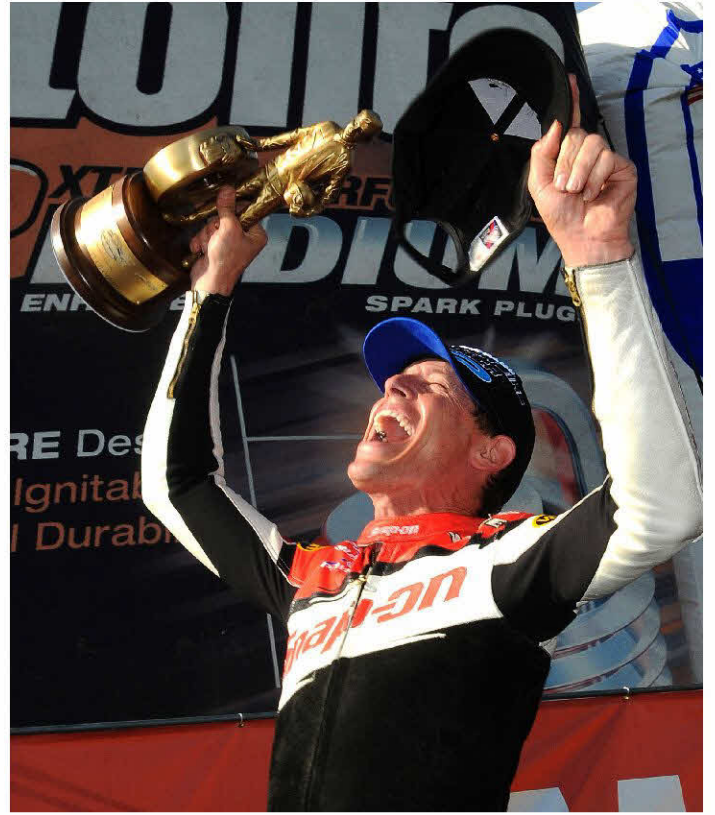
Johnson has competed on other race series and other types of motorcycle racing, as well. In 1987 and 1989, he was Drag Bike USA's Pro Stock Motorcycle Champion, and in 1989, he won the American Motorcyclist Association's Rebel Nationals.

2006 was the year an electronic error gave his victory to an opponent in a race so close that Johnson himself was stunned at the outcome. It was a bitter pill to swallow, but less than 24 hours later, after careful examination of the race video, it was apparent to all that Johnson had won by almost a wheel width

In 2007, Johnson finished among the top 10 in the NHRA Pro Stock Motorcycle Class. In 2008, he posted back to back wins in Indianapolis and Charlotte, earning him a brief second in point standings position. He ended the NHRA Full Throttle 2010 season sixth and ended the 2011 season in 13th position in Pro Stock Motorcycle point standings. His best speed to date is 196.27 m.p.h.

In connection with the NHRA's YES program, and with technical schools affiliated with his sponsors, he now gives career building tips to over 100,000 kids and young adults per year!
