Approximately 402 students participated in this field Trip Program.

This was the fourth Quick Tips on Winning in Life Field Trip Program for Kids at the Grand Prix of Long Beach supported by The Kenneth T. and Eileen L. Norris Foundation, which generously provided a grant, making the Program possible for area children in 2019. 
